It erases The opposite of undo is redo. most Windows applications , the Undo command is activated by pressing the Ctrl+Z or Alt+Backspace keybindings. Command SHORTCUT KEY. Procedure. Undo CTRL+Z, To reverse your last action, press CTRL+Z. You can reverse more than one action. Redo CTRL+Y, To . Many know to press Ctrl + Z when they want to undo their last entry. Redo is the opposite of undo, not a command to repeat your last entry or action. The shortcut to do the opposite of CTRL + Z is CTRL + Y:).

You can press Undo (or CTRL+Z) repeatedly if you want to undo multiple steps. To repeat something simple, such as a paste operation, press Ctrl+Y or F4 (If.

Currently, when performing cell level actions such as cut/copy/paste, there is not way of undoing the actions. This makes it very easy to loose.

A background job is just one that is not interacting with the user -- it doesn't control the tty and it just does its thing (generally silently).

Each click reverses one more action. Continue clicking Undo (or pressing Control +Z) to remove as many of the previous changes as necessary.
